Resource updates must be provided to SDWF annually no later than January 31 to be listed in IROC by GPC for the upcoming fire season. Not all resources are eligible for IROC entry. Water tenders must carry appropriate hose, clamps, adapters, and tools to be able to fill engines and/or portable tanks including national standard thread, national hose (NH,) national pipe standard hose (NPSH), and/or from camlock to fire thread. All types will meet federal, state, and agency requirements for motor vehicle safety standards including all GVW ratings when fully loaded.
